

CALL FOR TUTORIALS



Welcome to the 2026 IEEE International Symposium on Information Theory (ISIT 2026) that will take place from June 28 to July 03 in Guangzhou, China!

Guangzhou, also known as Canton, is a vibrant metropolitan and the capital city of Guangdong province in southern China. It is also widely called China's southern capital. As a port city, Guangzhou is among the earliest cities that Chinese interacted with the world, with an open and friendly culture and unique heritage. In modern times, Guangzhou continues to play an important role in the country's modernization, pivoting the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area (GBA).

ISIT 2026 seeks half-day tutorial proposals, which should provide clear and focused teaching material covering new and emerging topics within the scope of the conference.

The tutorial proposal should describe concisely the content, importance, and timeliness of the tutorial. It should contain the following sections:

- | Title of tutorial.
- | Tutorial abstract.
- | Importance and timeliness of tutorial.
- | Outline of tutorial.
- | Name(s) of tutorial lecturer(s). If there are multiple lecturer(s), a distribution of the tutorial content among them.
- | Brief CV for each tutorial lecturer (no more than 300 words per person).
- | Previous lecture and tutorial experience of the tutorial lecturer(s).
- | Whether similar tutorials have been presented at previous ISITs or cognate conferences (e.g., ICASSP, ICC) and, if so, how this tutorial differs in scope.
